SECTION 1. Section 7.05 of Chapter 8 (Zoning Code), Article 2, Hawaii County Code, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

"7.05(p). The district classification of the following area situated at Keauhou 1st, North Kona, Hawaii, shall be Multiple Family Residential (RM-2.0):

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this ordinance shall take effect forthwith upon the conditions that (A) the applicant, Kamehameha Development Corporation, in behalf of the B. P. Bishop Estate, submit a consolidation and resubdivision plan and secure tentative approval within one (1) year of the date of approval of the change of zone request; and (B) all historical sites in the area be considered. Should the foregoing conditions not be met, action may be initiated to rezone the area to its former designation.

SECTION 3. In the event that any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.






