The park site shall be developed concurrently with the second increment and that the exact location and configuration of the park site shall be determined at the time of subdivision review of the second increment.

SECTION 3. In the event that any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.






