Pursuant to your September 30, 1992 letter requesting a boundary interpretation for the subject parcels, please be advised that based on the maps you provided, we have determined the approximate location of the State Land Use Agricultural / Conservation District boundary.

Please be advised that portions of the Agricultural / Conservation District boundary follow approximately a 300-foot setback from the shoreline, the location of which is subject to a current certified shoreline survey.

A blueline print of your maps with the approximate State Land Use Agricultural / Conservation District boundary delineated is enclosed for your reference.


