BOUNDARY INTERPRETATION No. 02-28

Portions of Tax Map Key Nos. 2-8-15:1 and 2-9-03:44

Hawaii Belt Road, Pepeekeo, Hawaii

Pursuant to your letter dated August 14, 2002, requesting a boundary interpretation for the subject parcels, please be advised that we have determined an approximate location of the State Land Use (SLU) Agricultural/Conservation District boundaries.

Our determination is based on the Commission's records and official maps currently on file at our office, including the official SLU District Boundaries Map dated December 20, 1974 (H-59); the 1969 Land Use Districts and Regulations Review; and marked tax maps dated January 1962 and February 1967 depicting the SLU boundaries for the subject parcels. Information found in these records indicates that:

- The SLU Agricultural/Conservation District boundaries for the subject parcels were established during the 1969 Five-Year Boundary Review.
- The 1969 Five-Year Boundary Review determined that Kolekole Valley was of such significance to the landscape that it was placed into the SLU Conservation District.
- The SLU Conservation District boundary relative to TMK 2-9-03: 44 follows the mauka side of the former Hawaii Consolidated Railway, Limited, railroad-right-of-way. This places the entire parcel within the SLU Conservation District.

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The SLU Agricultural/Conservation District boundary relative to TMK 2-8-15: 1
follows a 200-foot setback and the top of the ridge located on the southern side of
Kolekole Stream.

A copy of your map entitled "Map Showing Construction Parcels" with an approximate location of the SLU Agricultural/Conservation District boundaries delineated relative to the subject parcels is enclosed for your reference.
