On February 1, 1964, the band Use Commission voted to the request to amend the temporary district boundaries of your properties described in TMK 9-4-01: 8 and 9-4-02: 3, third division from an agricultural to an urban district.

The Commission voted with the knowledge that you had written to postpone action on your petition for an indefinite period.
