Gentlemen:

The Land Use Commission, at its meeting on June 12, 1964, voted to deny your petition for a boundary change from a temporary agriculture to a temporary urban district classification for approximately 23.15 acres in Keeli, Hawaii (TK 8-3-05 and 8-3-06).

A motion was made by Commissioner Inaba and seconded by Commissioner Wenkam to approve your petition. The vote was 3 approvals versus 4 denials. Since six approvals are needed for a boundary change, the motion was defeated because of insufficient votes.

Enclosed for your information is a copy of the Land Use Commission's staff report, which the Commission based its decision.
