The Planning Commission at its duly held public hearing on September 26, 1979 considered your application for a Special Permit to allow the establishment of an air surveillance radar facility on 1.8 acres of land situated within the State Land Use Agricultural District at Waiakea, South Hilo, Hawaii.

The Commission voted to approve your application effective September 26, 1979, subject to the following conditions:
