The Planning Commission at its regular meeting on October 30, 1979 considered your application for a Special Permit to allow the construction of another single family dwelling on 1.1 acres of land situated within the State Land Use Agricultural District at Hienaloli 1st, North Kona, Hawaii.

The Commission voted to approve your application effective October 30, 1979, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That a building permit for the second dwelling shall be secured by the petitioner, or his authorized representative, within one (1) year from the effective date of the Special Permit.
- 2. That construction shall commence within one (1) year from the date of receipt of the building permit and be completed within two (2) years thereafter.
- 3. That residents residing in the existing and proposed dwellings shall be limited to the petitioner or his/herheirs. Any change of ownership of the property and/or dwellings other than to the petitioner's heirs shall require the approval of the Planning Commission.
- 4. That all other applicable rules, regulations and requirements shall be complied with.
