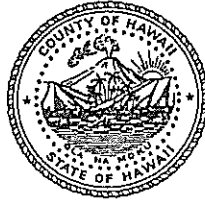



One of the goals of the Trust is to provide support of the educational programs and objectives of Parker School. In that light, the Trust felt that continuing with its application for an adult education center would only complicate matters and possibly compromise the outcome of the School's request.
