SUBJECT:

Review of Projects with Conservation District

We have reviewed the projects listed in your October 9, 1981 Memorandum and have the following to offer:

Generally, in any area which is under Executive Order (EO) for park purposes, a CDUA is not required for park improvements, unless there is a change or expansion in existing land use.

Areas which are not under EO will require a CDUA prior to improvements since they legally are not a State park. CDUA would be for the establishment of a State park.

These general comments apply to all except the Renovation of Hanalei Pier which is a non-conforming use in the Conservation District. Insofar as the work is to alleviate a public hazard, no CDUA is required.

Executive Grder No. 3744

Setting Aside Land for Public Purposes

By this Executive Order, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hamaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside for the following public purposes:

FOR STATE PARK PURPOSES, to be under the control and management of the State Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, and effective January 1, 1992, being that certain parcel of land designated as "Kealakekua Bay State Park," situate at land adjacent to Hikiau Heiau, Kealakekua, South Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, being also portion of Royal Patent 7533 and 3607, Land Commission Award 8452, Apana 9 to A. Keohokalole, conveyed to the Territory of Hawaii by Victor B. Harrel by Exchange Deed dated September 18, 1939 and recorded in Liber 1525, Pages 230-237 (Land Office Deed 6349), containing an area of 3.24 acres, all more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 21,692 and dated April 7, 1992.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, that upon cancellation of this Executive Order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the Division of State Parks shall, within a reasonable time restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.
