

Thank you for your August 31, 2004 letter and the opportunity to comment on the proposed subdivision of the subject property.

Na Ala Hele Staff and Advisory Council are in support of the County's position of providing access to the shoreline.

We further recommend that the developer provide lateral access consistent with the concept of the Ala Kahakai corridor. This can be accomplished by seeking consultation with our Na Ala Hele Advisory Council and the Superintendent for the Ala Kahakai National Historical Trail.

Currently, our abstractor is exploring existing trails that are shown on other maps. Based on the mandates of the Highways Act of 1892, which has been codified in Chapter 264 HRS, the State of Hawaii through the Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) may claim fee simple ownership of a trail laid out by 1892. Therefore, we recommend you defer approval of the preliminary plat map until our Division completes an abstract.
