I'm sorry, I don't have time to review the public access in detail on these. What the letters say basically looks OK but we have to redo because I held them for too long without signing.

On both these properties we have to make sure that they have a lateral historic trail that is supposed to be near the ocean, see tax maps for 8-7-7 and 8-7-5. We should also be trying to get an access along the road that people are using. So the approach in these letters seems correct.
