Thank you for inquiring about any concerns Ala Kahakai NHT may have as it pertains to the waterline improvement project at Keei.

Based on the maps that you sent and a previous site visit with State of Hawaii NAH staff, Count Planning, and Kamehameha representative Dale Fergustrom, and conversations with SHPD, it appears that the project will not impact lateral shoreline access in the Keei section of South Kona. We are also pleased to be informed that the project has been scaled back, eliminating a road, and utilizing base coarse to cover pipe versus excavation thus narrowing the footprint of the project and therefore not further impacting trails that are found nearby and within the project area.
