Wilson Okamoto Corporation, on behalf of Kamehameha Schools (KS) respectfully re-submits the Special Management Area (SMA) Application for the proposed waterline improvements project in Keei. The area that is subject of this application ("Project Area") is located in the South Kona District on the island of Hawaii and encompasses approximately 0.45 acres.

We previously submitted a SMA application on February 21, 2012 which was received by the Planning Department on April 4, 2012 (File No. SAA 12-000769). Approval of the SMA was contingent upon receiving a determination letter from the State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) on the archaeological assessment prepared for the project. We were unable to obtain the SHPD determination in a timely manner, therefore, we withdrew the SMA application on September 4, 2012.

We received the SHPD determination on the archaeological assessment on December 17, 2012 (see Attachment A). SHPD requested an archaeological monitoring plan be prepared, which KS will be preparing.

The project description and supporting information has not changed since previous submittal, hence, use our previous submittal. Our re-submittal, on behalf of KS, requests a SMA Minor approval for the proposed improvements.

We have also submitted a Conservation District Use Application to the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands. Please call me if you have any questions or require additional information.
