Kamehameha Schools (KS), a Hawai`i 501(c) nonprofit corporation, submitted an SMA Use Permit Assessment Application (SAA 12-000924) to the County of Hawai'i Planning Department dated January 7, 2013. The Planning Department reviewed the application and issued Special Management Area Minor Use Permit (SMM 13-000259), dated February 6, 2013.

In response to the Planning Department's October 24, 2013 response to KS' inquiry regarding the maintenance and repair to the existing jeep Road, KS would like to provide further clarification that all proposed work will be done within the surveyed 30 foot wide survey corridor established by Cultural Surveys Hawai'i (CSH) and approved by the State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD). The attached "figure 5" from the approved Archeological Inventory Survey (AIS) confirms that no historic properties identified in the AIS along the entire extent of the proposed work will be affected.

In addition, per SHPD's request, KS will deploy an archeological monitor from CSH to be present for the duration of the project in compliance with the approved monitoring plan. All work monitored by CSH will then be presented to SHPD as a supplemental report to the previous report on file.
